This course provides a level of training between Basic First Aid and the training provided to Emergency Medical Technicians. The purpose of this course is to provide familiarization with the symptoms, treatment, and skills necessary to respond to incidents of severe trauma. Attendees must have completed a basic CPR and First Aid course to understand the basis for the skill levels practiced in this course. By the nature of the course, the injuries and treatments discussed will always require follow-up professional medical assistance. Students are required to pass a written exam and practical skills demonstration for successful completion.

Expected Outcomes

Students will learn to identify and categorize symptoms of severe trauma and appropriate first aid treatments. They will also learn the types of information to be provided to emergency medical authorities for en route preparation.
